On Tuesday evening September 18th, 2007, Hampton Police began receiving calls for broken windows. Someone, probably travelling around by car, was breaking windows on parked cars and at businesses along the street. It's believed that ball bearings and marbles were used to cause the damage. This act of criminal mischief is estimated to have caused thousands of dollars in repairs. Areas damaged by the suspects included: Drakeside Road, Mill Road, High Street, Dearborn Avenue, and Ocean Boulevard.

Did you see a car driving in a suspicious manner? Did you hear anyone talking or joking about it? Police need your help to identify the suspects, or the car used in this crime.

Neighboring towns of Rye, North Hampton and Seabrook also reported similar acts of vandalism.
