



## PRESS RELEASE

March 3, 2007

The Hampton Police Department is announcing the arrest of three suspects for Armed Robbery. The robbery took place during the early morning hours of February 28, 2007 at the Mobil Xtra-Mart located at 685 Lafayette Road in Hampton, New Hampshire.

Through the combined efforts of Hampton Police Detectives, Officers assigned to the Patrol Division, and assistance from New Hampshire State Police they were able to piece together several important clues that led to the arrests.

Arrested for Robbery were:

LEO J. WILLWERTH, Age 20  
Hampton, NH

TYLER TILLEY, Age 19  
Seabrook, NH

GEORGE FALES, Age 22  
Seabrook, NH

WILLWERTH was arrested without incident at his apartment in Hampton, NH. FALES was arrested at the Rockingham County Jail in Brentwood, NH where he was already in custody for unrelated charges. TILLEY surrendered himself to Hampton Police Detectives at the Hampton Police Department without incident.

On 2/28/07 at approximately 1:30 AM two white males entered the Xtra-Mart. Both were wearing hooded sweatshirts, hats, and they concealed their faces. One of the suspects brandished a screwdriver and demanded money from the clerk. The suspects then fled the scene on foot. They were last seen heading east on Ann's Lane with an undisclosed amount of cash.

WILLWERTH and TILLEY are being held at the Rockingham County jail in lieu of \$15000 cash bail. The trio are scheduled for arraignment at the Hampton District Court on Monday morning 3/5/2007. Each will face one count of Robbery. Robbery is a Felony which is punishable by imprisonment up to fifteen years
