Ref: First-degree Assault

On July 9th 2008 at approximately 12:30am Hampton Police Officers had responded to a call reporting a fight on Keefe Ave near Ashworth Ave. While restoring peace at that location a female approached one of the officers and reported that her stepbrother had just stabbed her father. The female reported that her stepbrother's name is:

Robert Stubbert
Worcester, MA
28 years of age

The female further reported to the Officer that the suspect, Stubbert, had fled the scene.

The victim was found at 128 Ashworth Ave unit 23 (The Summer Wind Motel). The victim suffered a laceration to his left forearm near the elbow. The Hampton Fire Department transported the victim to the hospital.

Officers continued to search for the suspect who was reportedly wearing a black T-shirt bearing the words "U.S. BORDER PATROL".

Additional investigation allowed officers to intercept the brother of the suspect who had arrived in Hampton to pick up the suspect.

A short time later the suspect was located attempting to elude police in the area of Boston Ave and Ocean Boulevard.

Stubbert was arrested and charged with First-Degree Assault. He was not granted bail and was held without bail pending his arraignment later that morning in Hampton District Court.

During his arraignment the judge set a Probable Cause hearing for July 21, 2008 and reset his bail to \$25,000 cash and \$25,000 personal recognizance with the condition that the suspect not be bailed for 72 hours.
