Re: Arrest Warrant Service – Criminal Restraint

The Hampton Police Department is announcing the arrest of three suspects for Criminal Restraint and Criminal Liability for Conduct of Another. These charges are brought forward as felony crimes. The original incident took place on February 14, 2008 at a private residence in Hampton, New Hampshire.

Through the combined efforts of Officers assigned to the Patrol Division and Hampton Police Detectives an investigation was conducted which resulted in the issuance of three Arrest Warrants and a Search Warrant.

Arrested for Criminal Restraint RSA 633:2 were:

Robert ZUCCHARI, Age 38
Boston, MA

Nicholas THEISEN, Age 55
Marblehead, MA

Arrested for Criminal Liability for Conduct of Another RSA 626:8 was:

Jeaninne ANNO, Age 28
Malden, MA

ZUCCHARI and THEISEN were successfully arrested without incident just after 9pm on 2/28/08 at the Hampton Police Department. ANNO was arrested a short time later at her apartment in Hampton, NH. Members of the Seacoast Emergency Response Team assisted the Hampton Police Department with the arrests.

It is alleged that on 2/14/08 at approximately 6:30 PM the female victim answered a knock at her door. Three subjects who are neighbors of the victim forced their way into her apartment identifying themselves as Bail Recovery Agents. ZUCCHARI then pointed a handgun at the victims head. The victim was then handcuffed and questioned for a short time. The three subjects then removed the handcuffs and left the victims apartment.

The trio are scheduled for arraignment at the Hampton District Court on Friday morning 2/29/2008.
