Re: Crash on Lafayette Road

*For immediate release*

The Hampton Police Department is currently investigating a 3-vehicle collision at 380 Lafayette Road. Officers were called to the scene at 9:28am for a reported 3-car collision with entrapment. Both north and southbound lanes of Lafayette Rd were closed for approximately 1 hour.

The Hampton Fire Department responded and 3 persons were transported to the Hospital.

Officers at the scene interviewed involved parties and witnesses and determined that a van travelling northbound on Lafayette Road crossed over the solid double yellow lines when it struck a Volkswagen travelling southbound head on. The force of the impact caused the two vehicles to rotate in the roadway and a third vehicle travelling south bound behind the Volkswagen collided with the north bound van.

The driver of the northbound van has been identified as Christopher Reinhold 35 years of age from Salem, NH.

The driver of the southbound Volkswagen has been identified as Katherine Wayss, 31 years of age from Portsmouth, NH.

The driver of the southbound van has been identified as Nedim Aycaner 36 years of age from Portsmouth, NH.

The collision is still under investigation and charges may be forthcoming.
