At approximately 9pm On November 21, 2009 the Hampton Police Department was called to a residence on Brown Avenue for a reported assault. The Hampton Fire Department transported Joshua Egbert, 33, of 8A Brown Avenue to the Exeter Hospital. Mr. Egbert was subsequently transferred to a Boston area hospital with very serious injuries. Mr. Egbert remains in critical condition.

Hampton Police have arrested David Herrick, 38, and charged him with First Degree Assault. Mr. Herrick's bail was set at \$500,000.00 and he is being held at the Rockingham County Jail in Brentwood, NH.

Herrick will be arraigned via video today at 11:30 am at the Hampton District Court. Hampton Police Department continues to investigate this incident in conjunction with the New Hampshire Attorney Generals Office.
