Re: Arrest of Phillip Mitchell

The Hampton Police announce the arrest of 31 year old Phillip Mitchell of Hampton, NH for Reckless Conduct.

On March 14th 2016 the Hampton Police Department received a report of a male subject making suicidal threats with a handgun at approximately 1800 hours. Family members were still in the residence with the subject when Police arrived on scene. Officers were able to get the family to safely exit the residence.

The Seacoast Emergency Response Team was called to the scene as Mr. Mitchell was refusing to come out of the house. After lengthy negotiations Mr. Mitchell did agree to come out of the residence and surrender to Police at approximately 2255 hours.

Mitchell is charged with Reckless Conduct for placing others in danger of serious bodily injury. He is scheduled for arraignment on April 19th at the 10th Circuit Court in Seabrook, NH.
