Re: Updated Press Release from Stacey Janes Brawl

The Hampton Police Announce the arrests of the following subjects:

Christopher Walker, 23 years old from Hampton, NH
Cassie Walker, 21 years old from Hampton, NH
Caleb Butts, 23 years old from Amesbury, MA
Dylan Justus, 22 years old from Hampton, NH

On January 3rd the Hampton Police came upon a large fight outside Stacey Jane's Restaurant at 9 Ocean Blvd at approximately 0100 involving approximately 12 people. Police attention was drawn to Casey Walker who was actively fighting. She was removed from the group by police in order to place under arrest for disorderly conduct. As police were attempting to place her into custody Christopher Walker began to interfere with the arrest. During this struggle Christopher Walker assaulted a police officer and attempted to flee the scene. Police were able to apprehend Christopher Walker with the use of a taser.

Casey Walker was originally charged with Disorderly Conduct for fighting in a public place. Christopher Walker was originally charged with Disorderly Conduct for fighting in a public place, Obstructing Government Administration for interfering with the arrest, Simple Assault on a police officer, and Resisting Arrest or Detention.

An ongoing investigation of this incident has led to additional charges to both Casey and Christopher Walker as well as additional charges to Caleb Butts and Dylan Justus. All four were taken into custody on February 13th 2016.

Casey Walker is being charged with First Degree Assault (Felony Class A) for purposely attempting to cause serious bodily injury to another and Reckless Conduct (Felony Class B) for engaging in conduct which placed another in danger of serious bodily injury.

Christopher Walker is being charged with Attempt to Commit First Degree Assault (Felony Class A) for purposely attempting to cause serious bodily injury to another.

Dylan Justus is charged with Attempt to Commit Second Degree Assault (Felony Class B) for purposely attempting to cause serious bodily injury to another, Reckless Conduct (Felony Class B) for engaging in conduct which placed another in danger of serious bodily injury, and First Degree Assault (Felony Class A) for purposely attempting to cause serious bodily injury to another.

Caleb Butts is charged with Second Degree Assault (Felony Class B) for knowingly causing bodily injury to another under circumstances manifesting extreme indifference to value of human life and Reckless Conduct (Felony Class B) for engaging in conduct which placed another in danger of serious bodily injury.

The Hampton Police have active warrants for 21 year old Jacob Butts from Seabrook, NH for Attempt to Commit Second Degree Assault and Reckless Conduct which stemmed from the same incident.
