Re: Road Rage Incident leads to Felony Arrest

The Hampton Police Department announces the arrest of Michael Trumble, age 31 of Deerfield, NH, for the crime of Felony Criminal Threatening.

On June 26, 2016 at approximately 2:30pm the Hampton Police investigated a road rage incident that occurred on Route 101 in Hampton, near Hampton Beach. A witness identified seeing one of the parties involved in the road rage incident displaying a firearm. Shortly after, Michael Trumble was arrested on one count of Criminal Threatening with a deadly weapon. At the time of the arrest a 9mm Glock semi-automatic handgun was seized.

Michael Trumble was released on \$20,000 personal recognizance bail and is due to appear in the 10th Circuit Court in Seabrook on August 23, 2016.

Assisting in this investigation were the NH State Police, along with Epping and UNH Police Departments who were working on a mutual aid assignment in Hampton at the time of the incident.
