Re: Arrest of Maxwell Chaykowsky

The Hampton Police Announce the arrest of 18 year old Maxwell Chaykowsky of North Hampton, NH on Criminal Threatening (Felony).

Maxwell Chaykowsky was arrested on Monday December 18<sup>th</sup> at about 5:45 PM on a warrant for felony level Criminal Threatening with a deadly weapon. The arrest stemmed from an incident that occurred on Saturday December 16<sup>th</sup> in the area of Kings Highway and 9<sup>th</sup> Street where Mr. Chaykowsky placed another in fear of serious bodily injury or death by pointing, what was believed to be, a handgun into the victim's side after a physical altercation.

Mr. Chaykowsky was taken into custody in Hampton without incident. He was released on \$2500 Personal Recognizance Bail and is scheduled for arraignment on February 14, 2017 at the 10<sup>th</sup> Circuit Court in Seabrook, NH.

This incident is still under investigation and additional charges may be forthcoming. Anyone with information on this case is asked to contact the Hampton Police Department.
