Re: Criminal Threatening arrest

On February 19, 2016 at approximately 8:15pm, officers responded to a report of criminal threatening with a knife. Responding officers located the victim and learned that the suspect was last seen running south on Ashworth Ave. Officers also learned the identity of the suspect as they had dealt with him earlier in the shift. The suspect was identified as:

Jonathan Bik
35 years of age
Hampton, NH

Bik was spotted by officers looking for him as he was walking up M St., he was taken into custody at that time. A knife matching the description of the one used was also located.

Bik was processed and held at the Rockingham County Jail on \$1,000. until his arraignment on 2/22/16 when his bail was increased to \$15,000.

A probable cause hearing is scheduled for March 3, 2016.

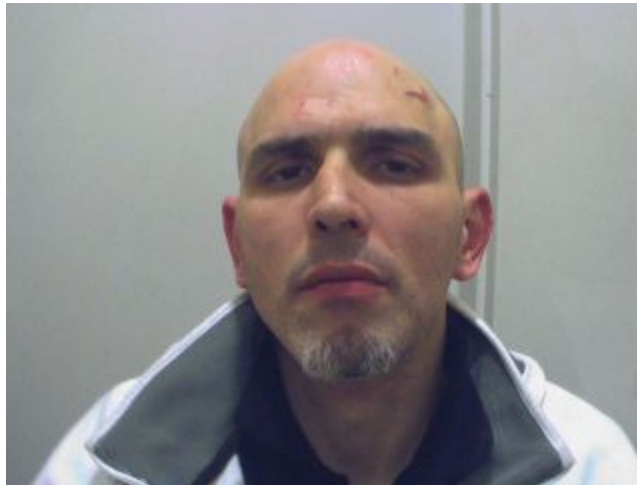
