Re: Shooting suspect Brayton Burnham

On October 27, 2016 at approximately 8:30pm Hampton Police Officers were requested to assist a Seabrook Officer with a burglary investigation that occurred in Seabrook. The Seabrook Officer was attempting to locate property at a residence (motel) in Hampton.

Officers went to the Mary Ann Motel, located at 2 Ocean Blvd. and attempted to speak with the occupants of room #19.

After several minutes, the occupants exited the room and spoke with officers in the courtyard.

Officers were granted permission to search the room and learned that there was a wanted person still in the room. Officers entered the room, one officer went to the bathroom area and while checking that room, was confronted by a subject later identified as Brayton Burnham. Burnham pointed a handgun at the officer and fired a single round in the direction of the Officer. The Officer retreated from the bathroom and all other officers exited the room. As they were making their way down the stairs they heard at least one other shot being fired. A perimeter was set up and officers attempted to call the suspect out of the room.

The Seacoast Emergency Response Team was activated and responded. After all efforts to communicate with the suspect failed a robot and a camera were deployed and it was discovered that the Burnham was deceased in the bathroom.

No Officers fired their weapons during this encounter and no Officers were wounded.
