Re: Tony Rosas Arrest

The Hampton Police announce the arrest of 36 year old Tony Rosas of Hampton, NH for Disobeying an Officer, Reckless Operation, Endangering Welfare of a Child, and Driving after Suspension.

On March 25th, 2016 at approximately 1900 hours an Officer observed Mr. Rosas operating a motor vehicle on Route 101. Mr. Rosas' driver's license was known to be under suspension. The Officer stopped Rosas's vehicle on Route 101 near the Rt 1 Interchange. Rosas pulled his vehicle over and stopped briefly. He then sped off at a high rate of speed and performed a u-turn on Route 101. Rosas continued to drive in a reckless manner and eventually stopped the vehicle in front of 8 Brown Ave. He was quickly taken into custody.

After Rosas was taken into custody Officers noticed a 7 year old girl was in the back seat that was unharmed.

Rosas was charged with Driving after Suspension, Disobeying an Officer, Reckless Operation, and Endangering the Welfare of a Child.

Rosas was released on \$2500 Personal Recognizance Bail and is scheduled for an arraignment on May 3rd, 2016 at the 10th Circuit District Court in Seabrook, NH.
