Re: Reckless Operation Arrest (111mph in 55mph zone)

The Hampton Police Department has arrested and charged a Manchester man with Reckless Operation.

Police allege that Roobens Maurice, 18, of Manchester, NH was operating a 2011 Hyundai Sonata on July 27, 2016 at 8:10pm, on Route 101 Eastbound in Hampton. Police allege that a Hampton police officer conducting traffic enforcement on Route 101 caught Maurice traveling at a speed of 111 mph in a posted 55 mph zone. Maurice was cited on scene for speed and later turned himself in to the Hampton Police Department on a warrant for the Reckless Operation.

Maurice was released and is scheduled to appear at the 10th Circuit Seabrook District Court on September 13, 2016 at 8:00am. Reckless Operation is a violation level offense with a possible penalty of \$1000.

The Hampton Police Department is continuing speed enforcement patrols on Route 101 as well as other high traffic areas in the town of Hampton. Police encourage motorists to exercise care for the safety of everyone and to obey the posted speed limits.
