Re: Arrest of Mark Wright

The Hampton Police Announce the arrest of 52 year old Mark Wright of Hampton, NH for Sale of a Controlled Drug and Theft from a Building.

On January 31, 2016 Mark Wright was arrested on two separate warrants. The first warrant stemmed from an investigation In June of 2015 where Mr. Wright did knowingly sell a quantity of a controlled drug being heroin to a person cooperating with law enforcement.

On January 28, 2016 the Hampton Police investigated Mr. Wright for Theft from a Building for obtaining control over food and alcoholic beverages from Mobile Alltown.

Mr. Wright was taken into custody on both charges on January 31st without incident. Mr. Wright is out on bail and is scheduled to appear in the 10th Circuit District Court on March 8th, 2016 for an arraignment.
