Re: Arrest of Sean Partridge

The Hampton Police Department has arrested and charged an Ayer, Massachusetts man with Second Degree Assault related to a Domestic Violence incident in Hampton.

On Saturday August 6, 2016 at approximately 10:54pm, officers from the Hampton Police Department responded to the area of B Street for a report of a man attacking a woman on a deck of a second floor hotel room. Upon arrival, officers located a victim in the room along with the victim's boyfriend, identified as Sean Partridge, 39, of Ayer, Massachusetts.

Upon investigating the incident, officers found evidence to support a felony charge of Second Degree Assault by way of strangulation and arrested Partridge. Bail was set at \$500 cash and Partridge is scheduled to appear at the 10th Circuit - Seabrook District Court on August 23, 2016 for his arraignment.

The Hampton Police Department is continuing to investigate the incident. They encourage any victims of domestic violence who are in need of assistance, to please call New Hampshire's statewide domestic violence hotline at (866) 644-3574.
