Re: Suspicious Object

The Hampton Police Department investigated a report of a suspicious object in the area of 603 Lafayette Road.

On Sunday August 8, 2016 at approximately 5:54pm, officers from the Hampton Police Department responded to the area of Seacoast Power Sports and Burger King on Lafayette Road to investigate the suspicious object. Officers worked with the Hampton Fire Department and the NH State Police Explosive Ordinance Disposal Unit to further investigate. Investigation by the EOD determined that the object was not dangerous and the item was disposed of. There was no danger to the public.

In an effort to ensure the safety of those around the immediate area, Burger King was temporarily shut down out of an abundance of caution, but re-opened after approximately an hour and a half.

The Hampton Police Department is continuing to investigate the incident.
