Re: Arrest of Armand Hennis

The Hampton Police announce the arrest of 49 year old Armand Hennis of Hampton, NH for First Degree Assault.

On May 15th at 5:45 pm the Hampton Police Department responded to 9 Cole St. for a report of an assault that just occurred. Police were able to identify the suspect at the scene as Armand Hennis. Police learned that Mr. Hennis assaulted the victim with a knife causing a serious laceration to the victim's throat. The victim was transported to the hospital and sustained non-life threatening injuries.

Mr. Hennis was arrested for First Degree Assault for causing bodily injury with a deadly weapon. Hennis was arraigned on Tuesday May 16th and is currently held on \$50,000 cash bail. He is scheduled for a Probable Cause hearing on May 25th at 1 pm at the 10th Circuit Court in Seabrook, NH.

This is an ongoing investigation and anyone with information is asked to contact the Hampton Police Department.
