Re: Arrest of Michael Brady

The Hampton Police announce the arrest of 38 year old Michael Brady of Hampton, NH on two charges of Endangering the Welfare of a Child.

On Tuesday December 26th 2017 Mr. Brady was arrested at about 10:30am following a motor vehicle stop on Landing Rd in Hampton, NH. The arrest stemmed from an ongoing investigation where warrants were obtained for Brady on two charges of Endangering the Welfare of a Child.

Police allege that Brady knowingly endangered the welfare of a child under the age of 18 by purposely violating a duty of care and protection or support owed to such child by inducing the child to engage in delinquent behavior that includes alcohol and drug use.

It is also alleged that Brady knowingly endangered the welfare of a child under the age of 18 by purposely inducing a child to engage in conduct that endangers his health or safety by providing the minor with alcohol.

Brady has been released on \$2000 PR Bail and is scheduled for arraignment on February 20th at the 10th Circuit Court in Seabrook.
