Re: Arrest of Parker Daudette

The Hampton Police announce the arrest of 18 year old Parker Daudette from Seabrook, NH for Robbery, Simple Assault, and Unlawful Possession of Alcohol.

On Friday April 28<sup>th</sup> at 11:30pm the Hampton Police received a report of an Assault that occurred at 9 Ocean Blvd, Stacey Janes Grille and Bar, and a Robbery that occurred on the Underwood Bridge. During the investigation Police identified Parker Daudette as the suspect. After leaving Stacey Janes the victim was approached again by Daudette again on the Underwood Bridge. It is alleged that Daudette stole an undisclosed amount of cash and personnel belongings from him.

Police located Daudette at 9 Ocean Blvd with the assistance of the New Hampshire Bureau of Liquor Enforcement. Officers determined that Daudette was under the influence of alcohol and was charged with Unlawful Possession of Alcohol, Simple Assault for causing unprivileged physical contact with the victim, and Robbery.

Daudette is currently being held on \$5000 cash bail and is scheduled for a Probable Cause hearing on May 10<sup>th</sup> at the 10<sup>th</sup> Circuit District Court in Seabrook, NH.

The Hampton Police will continue to work closely with the New Hampshire Bureau of Liquor Enforcement to ensure liquor establishments are complying with all Administrative Rules and to improve public safety for everyone that lives, works, and visits this community.
