Re: Arrest of Joshua Sweetapple

The Hampton Police announce the arrest of 40 year old Joshua Sweetapple from Hampton, NH for Domestic Violence: Assault, Burglary (Felony), Criminal Threatening, and Aggravated Driving While Intoxicated.

On October 17th at approximately 12:48 am police responded to 415 Ocean Blvd after receiving several phone calls through 911 of a disturbance in the building. Mr. Sweetapple was located at the scene and police received conflicting reports from the parties involved.

The investigation continued and police gathered additional evidence and determined that Mr. Sweetapple did enter an apartment at 415 Ocean Blvd. with the purpose to commit the crime of assault. It was also determined that he did threaten to commit the crime of assault against a person within the property, did recklessly cause bodily injury to another by pushing the victim, and did operate a motor vehicle while under the influence.

Mr. Sweetapple turned himself into the Hampton Police Department on warrants issued for Domestic Violence Assault, Burglary, Criminal Threatening, and Aggravated Driving while Intoxicated on November 7th at 8:50 am.

Mr. Sweetapple was released on PR Bail and scheduled for court on November 16th 2018 at the Rockingham County Superior Court in Brentwood, NH.
