Re: Bessemer Violation of Bail Conditions

The Hampton Police announce the arrest of 57 year old Beth Bessemer of Hampton, NH for Default or Breach of Bail Conditions.

On September 17th 2018 Bessemer was arrested and charged with two counts of Cruelty to Animals, both Class A Misdemeanor offenses. She was released on her own recognizance by a bail commissioner and is scheduled to be arraigned on October 30, 2018.

On October 12th 2018 Bessemer was arrested for Default or Breach of Bail Conditions. Police allege that Bessemer did knowingly violate a criminal bail order, which was issued by the court on October 2nd, 2018, by having customers' pets in her custody unsupervised and failed to post copies of criminal complaints as directed by the court.

Bessemer turned herself in to Police at the Hampton Police Department at about 2:20 pm. She was released on personal recognizance and given a court date of November 13th 2018 at 8am at the 10th Circuit District Court in Seabrook, NH. Her conditions of bail state that she shall have no contact with other person's pets supervised or unsupervised.
