Re: Provident Bank Robbery

On Tuesday April 17<sup>th</sup> 2018 the Hampton Police received notification of a panic alarm coming from the Provident Bank at 321 Lafayette Rd at about 3:30 pm. Several units responded and it was determined that a white male subject had entered the bank and demanded money.

No weapon was shown and Police were able to determine that the suspect left in a red or maroon vehicle south on Lafayette Rd. The male subject is believed to be between 40 and 50 years old and approximately 5'07 in height.

This investigation is still ongoing as Investigators are reviewing surveillance video and talking to witnesses. Photographs of the suspect are attached and anyone with information is asked to contact HPD.
