Re: Arrest of Daniel Hammond

The Hampton Police announce the arrest of 34 year old Daniel Hammond of Hampton, NH for the charges of Domestic Violence, Violation of a Protective Order, and Criminal Threatening.

On February 22nd at approximately 3:17pm the Hampton Police took a report of Criminal Threatening from a concerned party. Officers investigated the allegations that included a threat to shoot a female, a juvenile, and another male subject. The suspect in the case was identified as Daniel Hammond. Investigators found a restraining order had been taken out by the female party against Mr. Hammond and that the threats were a violation of that order. Arrest warrants were sought for two Class A Misdemeanor charges of Violation of a Protective Order.

Mr. Hammond was located and arrested with the assistance of the Rye, NH Police Department. After further investigation, those charges were upgraded to Class B Felony charges. Additionally, two counts of Domestic Violence Criminal Threatening, and one count of Criminal Threatening, all Class B Felonies, were charged. He is currently being held at the Rockingham County Jail on a No Bail status pending his arraignment at the Rockingham County Superior Court on February 23, 2018 at 11:00am.

The investigation of this case is ongoing. Prosecution of these matters will be handled by the Rockingham County Attorney's Office.
