Re: Motor vehicle vs. pedestrian collision

On 5/23/17 at approximately 9:15 pm the Hampton Police Department responded to a report of a motor vehicle accident involving a pedestrian on Ashworth Avenue near the intersection of L St.

Arriving officers found the vehicle involved stopped at the scene and an unconscious pedestrian on the side of the road.

Preliminary investigation shows that the pedestrian was in the crosswalk walking westerly, when he was struck by a 2014 Cadillac being driven by 80 year old David Mahoney of Nashua, NH.

The pedestrian has been identified as: 64 year old David Lavoie of Hampton, NH.

Lavoie was transported to the Portsmouth Regional Hospital in Portsmouth, NH where he remains with serious injuries.

Mahoney has been arrested and charged with vehicular assault. He has an arraignment date of July 25, 2017 at 0830am. He has been released on \$1,000 PR bail.

The investigation is ongoing and additional charges could be forthcoming.
