Re: Arrest stemming from unruly crowd

The Hampton Police announce the arrest of 23 year old Monytoung Maker from Manchester, NH for Riot stemming from an incident at Hampton Beach on June 20th.

On Sunday July 26th the Hampton Police were issued a warrant for Mr. Maker for the charge of Riot. This charge was the result of an ongoing investigation that began on June 20th with an incident that began at the New Hampshire Seashell Complex that involved a large gathering of 300-400 individuals gathered in the area. Police had made multiple attempts to disperse the group which were ignored as the group continued to grow while engaging in unruly behavior including drug and alcohol use.

In an effort to disperse the group the Hampton Police along with our Law Enforcement partners gathered to the south of the group and were eventually able to disperse them.

Police were able to identify a number of those involved and identified Mr. Maker as the primary instigator of the incident. He was taken into custody without incident at approximately 8pm on July 26th in the area of Ocean Blvd. and F Street for Riot (Misdemeanor Class A) for engaging in tumultuous or violent behavior and creating a substantial risk of public alarm. Mr. Maker was released on bail and is scheduled for arraignment on September 15th at 1pm at the Hampton District Court. Police are still investigating this incident and ask anyone with information to contact the Hampton Police Department.
