Re: Thomas Littlewood Domestic Felony Assault Arrest

The Hampton Police announce the arrest of 37 year old Thomas Littlewood of Gardner, MA on two Class B Felony charges of Second Degree Assault and one Misdemeanor charge of Criminal Mischief.

On March 24<sup>th</sup>, 2018 at about 11:00 pm Police received a report of an on-going altercation in a hotel room at 295 Ocean Blvd. Mr. Littlewood was located outside along Ocean Blvd. near A Street as Officers responded to the call and determined that Mr. Littlewood had been involved an altercation.

Police checked on the room where the initial altercation had been reported and determined that Mr. Littlewood did cause Serious Bodily Injury to the victim by hitting her in the face causing her to lose a tooth. It is also alleged that Mr. Littlewood knowingly engaged in an act of strangulation to the victim as well as caused damage to a cell phone of another.

Mr. Littlewood was charged with two charges of Second Degree Assault (Felony - Class B) and one charge of Criminal Mischief (Misdemeanor).

Mr. Littlewood was released on \$500 cash bail and is scheduled for arraignment on April 6<sup>th</sup> at 0800 at the Rockingham Superior Court.

This case is still under investigation and is being handled by the Rockingham County Attorney's Office..
