Re: Burglary Arrest

The Hampton Police Department announces the arrest of 41 year old Justin Knowles from Hampton, NH for Attempt to Commit Burglary and Falsifying Physical Evidence.

On March 1st 2020 at 11:48pm Police received a report of someone breaking into a residence at 467 Ocean Blvd. Police were quickly able to identify the male subject as Justin Knowles who had fled from the scene.

Police allege that Knowles did commit the crime of Burglary for entering an occupied structure with the intent to commit a theft as well as Falsifying Physical Evidence for concealing evidence utilized during the commission of the Burglary.

Knowles was taken into custody without incident and released on PR Bail. He is scheduled for arraignment on March 12th at the Rockingham County Superior Court at 1pm. This case has been referred to the Rockingham County Attorneys Office.

The Hampton Police encourages everyone to report all suspicious activity.
